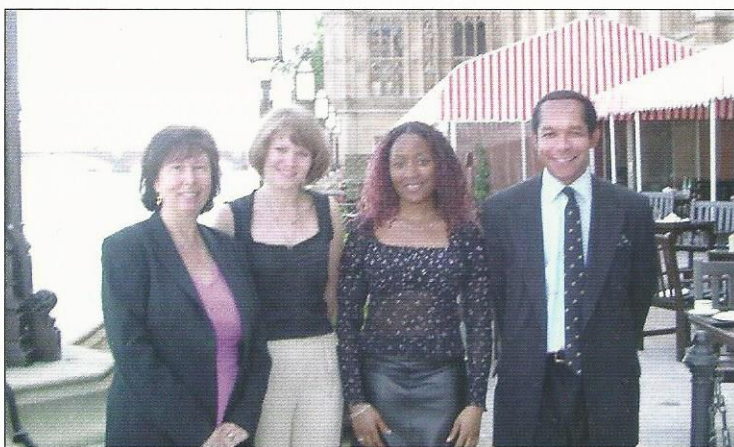

20th January: *WLF* launches Jamaican Hospital Appeal in the Voice newspaper, in conjunction with the Golding Trust.



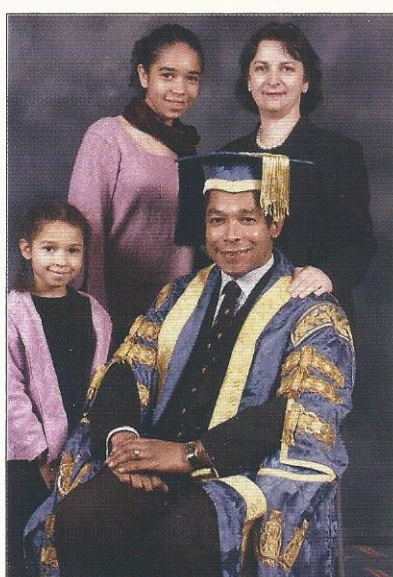

18th June: Suzana represents *WLF* at the Global Heroes Awards, Foreign and Commonwealth Office.



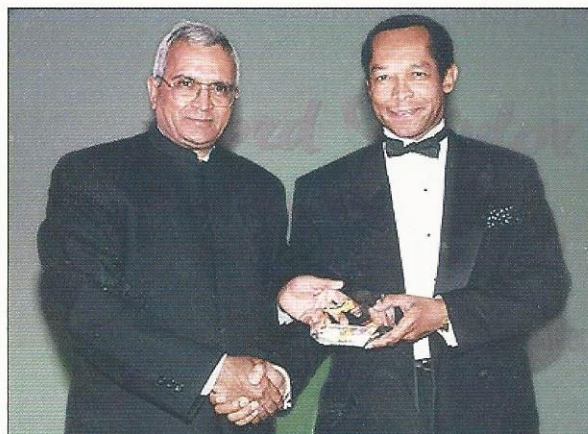

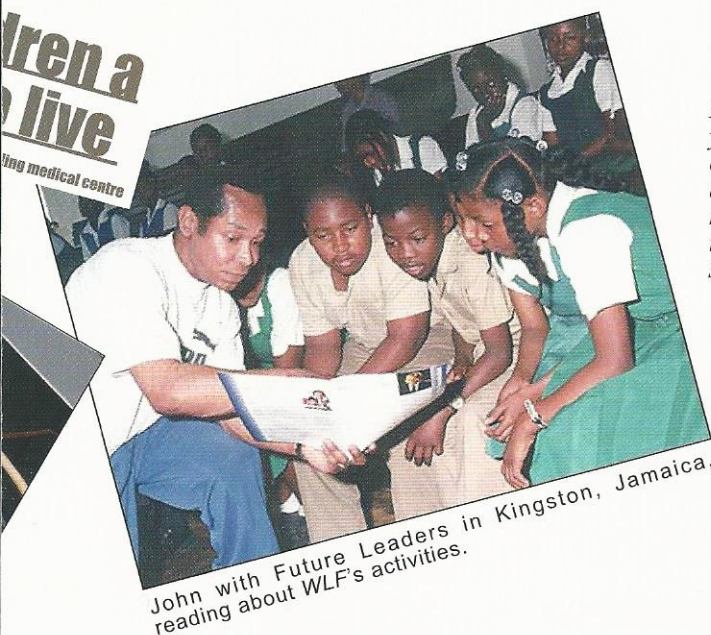
